Christies Beach Tourist Park rules and regulations

Vehicles	The speed limit for any vehicle within the park is walking pace only – 6km/hr. You may be asked to leave the park if breaches of the speed limit occur. Pedestrians have right of way at all times. Vehicles are only to be parked on designated parking areas or sites. Only vehicles registered with the park office may enter the park. Only one vehicle per site at any time, this includes all boats, trailers and motorbikes, unless prior arrangements have been made with management (fees apply).	Emergencies	All guests and residents are to make themselves familiar with the evacuation procedures in the case of an emergency. If you require ambulance, police or fire service call 000 immediately, then contact the 24-hour number provided to assist the service called. Any injury sustained in the park by all residents, contractors, guests or visitors must be reported to management immediately. An incident report must then be completed.	Ball games	Management reserves the right to halt rowdy or dangerous play and parents must accept responsibility for the conduct, behaviour and any liability for damage or injury to their children or others.
Entrance gates	Access granted for those with vehicles registered with the office.	Fire regulations	Fires must be contained and on a heat proof surface. Drawbars for vans and trailers must face the roadway to comply with SA Fire Safety Legislation.	Bikes, scooters, skateboards, rollerblades, rollerskates etc	When riding bikes, scooters, skateboards, rollerblades, rollerskates within the park: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Helmets must be worn at all times. • Speed limits must be obeyed. • Must not be ridden on walkways around amenities and camp kitchen areas. • Children under eight years of age must be accompanied by parent/guardian when riding on the park roads. Management reserves the right to confiscate any of the above equipment for the duration of your stay, for any breach of these conditions.
Visitors	Your visitors are your responsibility and must adhere to park rules and regulations. Overnight visitors must register with reception upon arrival. Non-paying visitors must leave the park by 10pm. Shower facilities are only available to paying, overnight visitors. Anyone entering the park may be asked by management to identify themselves.	Smoking	Smoking is permitted in designated areas only. No smoking is permitted in shared areas, including the camp kitchen, BBQ area, playgrounds and amenities block.	Pedal carts	Pedal cart rules will be supplied at time of hire and must be adhered to.
Pets	We allow pets at all times on sites (except cabins). Conditions apply. For more information please contact reception. Service dogs with identification documents are exempt from our pet policy.	Rubbish	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recycling – placed in the yellow lidded bins • General waste – bagged and placed in the blue lidded bins • Cans and bottles – place in containers provided • All other waste (eg hard rubbish) – must not be placed in or around park bins and must be taken with you. 	Park property	Guests staying at the park take full responsibility for any damage and/or breakages incurred during their stay.
Sites	Please do not walk through sites. Pedestrians use marked paths and roads. Maximum of six persons per site. The tariff includes two people and cannot be transferred from the guest who made the booking. To protect our grass sites, the maximum length of stay in a tent or camper trailer is seven nights. Caravan bookings of more than 14 days will be booked on a slab site for easier maintenance. Use only breathable matting for flooring, to protect grass. Sites must be kept neat and tidy. Management must have easy access to maintain any lawn area around your site, and not be hindered by your possessions. Management may ask guests to move sites at any time.	Post and parcels	The tourist park cannot be regarded as your principal place of residence. Please do not use this address for any purposes such as motor registration compliance or for inclusion on the electoral roll. Occasional mail addressed to you may be sent to the park and held for collection during office hours.	Personal belongings	The park takes no responsibility for any lost or stolen items from accommodation or vehicles. We recommend that guests securely lock their accommodation and/or motor vehicle when unoccupied.
Utilities	One approved 15 amp power cord is to be used per socket. Utility hoses, cables or pipes must be of the required standard, must not cause a tripping or obstruction hazard, and be kept leak free. Grey water hoses must be placed into drains. Items of park infrastructure and equipment must not be dismantled or modified. Please report any utility defects to the park office immediately.	Noise	Noise levels are to be kept to a minimum at all times for the comfort of everyone. Excessive noise or loud parties will not be tolerated under any circumstances. All noise must cease at 10pm. Please keep noise to a minimum before 8am.	Washing vehicles	Using a bucket or pressure sprayer to wash cars, boats or vans is permitted, however any hoses must have a trigger action nozzle.
Cabins	Maximum occupants are dependent on the cabin category. Number of persons accommodated in a cabin may not exceed the number of beds provided due to fire restrictions. All cabins are non-smoking. If evidence of smoking is found, a cleaning fee will be applied to your account.	Park conduct and behaviour	Management reserves the right to immediately evict any guest, visitor or member of the public for any illegal or anti-social behaviour, including but not limited to: excess alcohol consumption; possession, sale or use of illegal drugs and substances; wilful damage to park property; theft; physical and/or verbal abuse of staff, other guests and/or the public. In this instance, the Customer Access Restriction Procedure will be enforced. Smoking and the consumption of alcohol by minors is strictly prohibited. Any breach of these conditions will result in police attendance. Please report any unusual or illegal activities to the park manager immediately.	Water restrictions	This park operates under a Water Wise Measures permit issued by SA Water. Grass sites may only be watered once per week for a maximum of 30 minutes. Long-term residents must follow current Water Wise Measures for domestic gardens and lawns, visit www.sawater.com.au for details.
		Children	Children's behaviour and safety is at all times the responsibility of the parents/guardians. All children under eight years must be accompanied by an adult when using park facilities. Persons under 18 years are not permitted to be in the park without a parent/guardian.	BBQ's	Free BBQs and surrounding areas are available for all guests and their visitors. They must be cleaned after use, once cooled to a safe temperature. Please do not pour liquids on them at any time.
				Camp kitchen	The camp kitchen is available for all guests and visitors, so please clean up anything you have used and turn off all appliances after use. Management takes no responsibility for any food, items or equipment that is stored in the camp kitchen area.
				Office hours	Check the office door for current opening hours and out-of-hours contact number in case of an emergency.
